A Letter From the Companion-in-Charge

Greetings,

To say that 2020 was not as expected seems a bit trite, but, for the SCHC as an organization, this year was an incredible year in spite of COVID-19.

When the year began, a number of activities were underway—revision of our bylaws was progressing. Plans for two regional conferences, one in Minneapolis and the other Maryland/DC area, as well as plans for our annual Companion Conference at Adelynrood were taking shape. Then COVID-19 hit, bringing much to a halt as we struggled with the difficult decision to not open Adelynrood for the summer. Sadness fell like a pall for a few weeks, but then Companions, Discerners, and our staff picked up and moved forward.

Virtual technology grabbed our attention. Meetings—committees, Annual Meeting with more than 150 attending, and Assembly—all took place. The regional conference planning committees re-tooled their events to a virtual format. The Midwest conference, *Listening to Indigenous Voices: What Do We Need to Hear?* enlightened us to the ways the European settlers of this continent tried to desecrate the customs, spiritual practices, and ways of life of the people already living here. We also learned from their descendants about ways they are seeking to relearn and bring back their ancestors' ancient practices and spirituality today.

The Mid-Atlantic Conference, *Liberating Love through Prayer and Action*, helped us discover the "specks in our eyes" regarding racism that is so embedded in us. Ruby Sales, who began her fight against this plague as a young girl in Mississippi, spoke of her experience but, mostly and movingly, she spoke about the power of love.

The Companion Conference planned for 2020 will be held in 2021 with the title *Courage to Risk, to Love, to Act.* This, too, will be a virtual conference because we have learned that this format opens the doors to all members no matter where they are in the world.

In the meantime, Adelynrood sat empty, but not without activity. The SCHC staff set about using this time to do catch-up on projects that usually take a backseat to activities going on when Companions, Discerners, and guests gather. Lots of cleanup and maintenance work took place, both inside and outside the house. Office files were reorganized and normal day-to-day financial, publication, and office activities continued. Our staff stood steadfast.

Of course, for members of the Society, having Adelynrood closed has been sad, but we've learned that we can still pray together through virtual noonday services of intercession five days a week. We have learned how to use virtual technology to gather as chapters, and to enlighten each other in programs and meetings. Even more important, we have learned that technology and praying can go together to connect us and may even strengthen our bonds of community.

Yes, the year was not as we ever imagined, but this Society of strong women continues as a healthy, active, praying organization. For that I give thanks! Peace and blessings,

GOING FORWARD IN A TIME OF COVID-19:

Living in a Virtual World

School for Spiritual Direction



The Adelynrood School for Spiritual Direction met by Zoom in June and August 2020, with 17 students attending.

Thanks to excellent tech support, it all went smoothly from mini-retreats to graduation, including break out groups, spiritual direction practice, prayer times and social hours. Students who find it hard to travel to Adelynrood for the in-person school were delighted to be able to attend virtually. Our Zoom gathering was both surprising and pleasing – a mixed blessing.

Midwest Regional Conference – Listening to Indigenous Voices: What Do We Need to Hear?

This four-day virtual conference attracted nearly 100 people who came to learn about the current realities of Native American peoples from Native American



presenters. We experienced spirituality from the cultural lens of Native nations in the Midwest region, heard the historical account of the Doctrine of Discovery, and received a taste of language, story telling, traditional food sources, basket weaving, and art. The conference provided insight and inspiration to all participants.

Noonday Intercessions

A group of Companions thought that gathering for virtual noonday intercessions would help us to stay connected during our time of COVID isolation. Zoom intercessions are now held



five times a week. About 20-25 women from across the Companionship participate each day, and about 40 consider themselves as regulars. Chapters take turns planning prayers, so the variety of voices, styles, and topics keep noonday intercessions interesting and relevant. All are welcome to join!

Mid-Atlantic Regional Conference – Liberating Love through Prayer and Action

Over 70 participants from across the country listened to presenters Ruby Sales and Peter and Rhondesia Jarrett-Schell talk about confronting injustice and racism in our society by engaging in the work of listening more and speaking less. In Zoom breakout sessions, prayers were written to process and gain deeper understanding from the presentations. Virtual worship grounded us in prayer and all were energized by Ana Hernandez's virtual sing-along.
